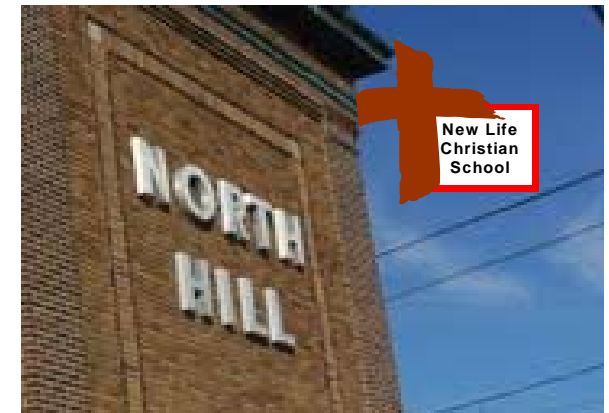

New Life Christian School Athletic Program

New Life Christian School's Athletic Program is continuing to rapidly blossom and grow. Currently, we are members of the Niagara Frontier Christian Athletic Association (NFCAA), in which we participate in soccer, basketball, volleyball, and cross-country running.

Basketball and volleyball have been played at New Life for several years, and as our most popular sports, we have continued to improve, season by season. The boy's basketball team (22-5) ended this season with 2 championship titles, the New York Christian Athletic Association Small School State championship and the NFCAA title. The girls also ended a competitive volleyball season with a 12-3 record. But as our teams continue to succeed, our facility remains lacking. We rent the St. Bonaventure Fitness Facility in Olean for our home games during the sports season. This has been useful, however, it is cumbersome when scheduling, preparing for games, transporting seats for players and fans, and it is also costly, especially in the long run.

THE GYMNASIUM

PRESENT...

Having been rewarded with numerous successes, NLCS sports facilities have still remained an issue. Currently, our gymnasium on campus is not large enough to use for our basketball or volleyball requirements, both in terms of court size and seating capacity, thus the reason we rent the St. Bonaventure Fitness Center's basketball facility for our home games. But with poor heating and insulation, inadequate restrooms, no installed seating, and poor lighting and court conditions, this facility is insufficient for our Athletics Program. As a result, plans are being made to procure a new facility to suit our sporting needs.

HOPES...

New Life Christian School is hoping to modify the gymnasium/auditorium facility. The idea of having a refined sports/theatre facility has been of great interest for years, and now plans are being brought to life in anticipation of an enhanced facility for NLCS events. This new facility will serve in various of capacities in addition to the sporting aspect, including regulation-sized court, adequate seating, and necessary sports equipment. It will also be the venue for Christmas Drama Productions, Graduation Ceremonies, and school related events and assemblies. However, this project is costly. With the entire building plan estimated at \$950,000.00 we need all the help we can get. Any substantial amounts in money or useful materials donated toward this worthy cause of improving children's lives while building quality character, will be appreciated.
